Initial Assessment:						
During your initial assessment, a Phoenix House counselor will ask you questions about your current situation,						
presenting problem and relevant history in several areas of your life, especially concerning your history of substance use. The counselor then will make a recommendation to you based on the information received. The						
recommendations usually include a combination of individual, group and family counseling.						
Individual counseling:						
Individual counseling is an ir	nteraction between a person who is in need of help (a \Box client \Box) and another person					
who is trained in helping ped	ople get "unstuck." A counselor helping a client overcome substance abuse may iors and attitudes leading to the use of intoxicants. The reasons for attending					
counseling sessions are man	ly, and the counseling strategies employed also vary from counselor to counselor. The					
one constant is that the cou	nselor focuses all energies on trying to help the client.					

Group Counseling:

Group counseling involves a group of clients who meet together, along with one or two trained staff members, to talk about their struggles and problems. These groups can take a variety of forms. Some focus on a specific topic or problem, while others address a number of different concerns. The group is able to give support, offer alternatives, or gently confront one another. In this way, difficulties are resolved, alternative behaviors are learned, and clients develop new social skills or ways of relating to people. Group counseling has been found to be a very effective means of treatment for substance use-related problems.
